

COVID-19 Vaccination Policy Progressive Discipline Policy for Students

A Chicago School student who fails to comply with the Immunizations policy as related to COVID-19 vaccination requirement will be subject to the below disciplinary consequences. The timeframe for tracking compliance is one semester. Compliance records are maintained by the COVID-19 Support Team.

A student who is dismissed from The Chicago School due to non-compliance with this policy is not entitled to a refund of tuition or fees.

First Instance of Non-Compliance

- 1. Campus access is restricted. Access privileges may be restored when the student complies with the policy.
- 2. A written warning will be issued to the student and copied to their Department Chair.

Second Instance of Non-Compliance

- 1. Campus access is restricted. Access privileges may be restored when the student complies with the policy.
- 2. A written warning will be issued to the student and copied to their Department Chair.
- 3. A hold will be placed on the student's account until they complete two online training courses: "Coronavirus 101: What You Need to Know" and "Coronavirus 109: What You Should Know About Variants".

Third Instance of Non-Compliance

- 1. Campus access is restricted for the remainder of the semester. The student will not be permitted to return to campus for the remainder of the semester.
- 2. The student will be referred to the Student Affairs Committee (SAC) for professional comportment and with a recommendation for dismissal.
