




#### Overall TCSPP Respondents

Of the respondents who are currently employed, 89.6% are employed in their field of study, 26.5% are self-employed, and 89.4% are working full time.










#### TCSPP Overall Respondents, 1 Year Post-Graduation (AY 2018-2019)

Of the respondents who are currently employed, 88.7% are employed in their field of study, 21.1% are self-employed, and 89.2% are working full time.










#### TCSPP Overall Respondents, 3 Year Post-Graduation (AY 2016-2017)

Of the respondents who are currently employed, 94.5% are employed in their field of study, 30.6% are self-employed, and 89% are working full time.








#### TCSPP Overall Respondents, 5 Year Post-Graduation (AY 2014-2015)






#### Overall TCSPP-Chicago Respondents






#### Overall TCSPP-Irvine Respondents


#### Overall TCSPP-Online Respondents








#### Overall TCSPP-Washington, DC Respondents
