




#### Overall TCSPP Respondents



Of the respondents who are currently employed, 80.3% are employed in their field of study, 17.6% are self-employed, and 88.5% are working full time.











#### TCSPP Overall Respondents, 1 Year Post-Graduation (AY 2015-2016)

Of the respondents who are currently employed, 82.8% are employed in their field of study, 13.8% are self-employed, and 88.4% are working full time.











#### TCSPP Overall Respondents, 3 Year Post-Graduation (AY 2013-2014)

Of the respondents who are currently employed, 81.6% are employed in their field of study, 20.8% are self-employed, and 90.2% are working full time.











#### TCSPP Overall Respondents, 5 Year Post-Graduation (AY 2011-2012)
