Of the respondents who are currently employed, 84.7% are employed in their field of study, 20.6% are self-employed, and 88.6% are working full time.











TCSPP Overall Respondents, 1 Year Post-Graduation (AY 2016-2017)







TCSPP Overall Respondents, 3 Year Post-Graduation (AY 2014-2015)


