





Of the respondents who are currently employed, 83.6% are employed in their field of study, 22.6% are self-employed, and 87.9% are working full time.











TCSPP Overall Respondents, 1 Year Post-Graduation (AY 2017-2018)

Of the respondents who are currently employed, 81.7% are employed in their field of study, 16.6% are self-employed, and 85.1% are working full time.











TCSPP Overall Respondents, 3 Year Post-Graduation (AY 2015-2016)








TCSPP Overall Respondents, 5 Year Post-Graduation (AY 2013-2014)






